Subject: Change to Laboratory Test Order Screen in EPIC



Summary:

As part of the Ingalls OneEpic go live, all laboratory orders in EPIC will now show information related to add-on testing that is only accurate for the Ingalls sites that are using EPIC Beaker in their laboratory including Chemistry, Coagulation, Hematology, Immunology, and Microbiology.

An example of this information is shown in the following screenshot in the red box.



This information is not accurate for the tests performed at the Hyde Park, Orland Park, Silver Cross, or Cancer Specialist of Indiana laboratories at this time and should be ignored.
