Subject: Rh Immune Globulin (RhIG / RhoPhylac) Distribution Changes

Effective Date: 3/25/2026

Summary:

Effective Wednesday March 25, 2026, **Rh Immune Globulin (RhIG / RhoPhylac)** distribution will transition from the Blood Bank to **Pharmacy management across the health system**, including ambulatory obstetrics clinics.

- Pharmacy will manage RhIG supply and distribution
- Clinics will request RhIG using the standard clinic medication order form
- RhIG will be stored in the clinic medication refrigerator
- Documentation will now occur in the MAR rather than sending a paper form back to Blood Bank.

Clinical indications, dosing, documentation, and postpartum evaluation processes remain unchanged.
