**Summary:**

On **Tuesday, July 14, 2026, starting at 8:30 am** the clinical laboratory will go-live with a new middleware computer system for chemistry and molecular microbiology testing.

This change is necessary due to the sunsetting of our current system.

During the go-live period, there may be a brief delay in the reporting of laboratory results for Hyde Park automated chemistry and automated molecular microbiology. The anticipated interruption is expected to be less than one hour.

Blood Gas Testing and Rapid Respiratory Testing will be available during this period.
